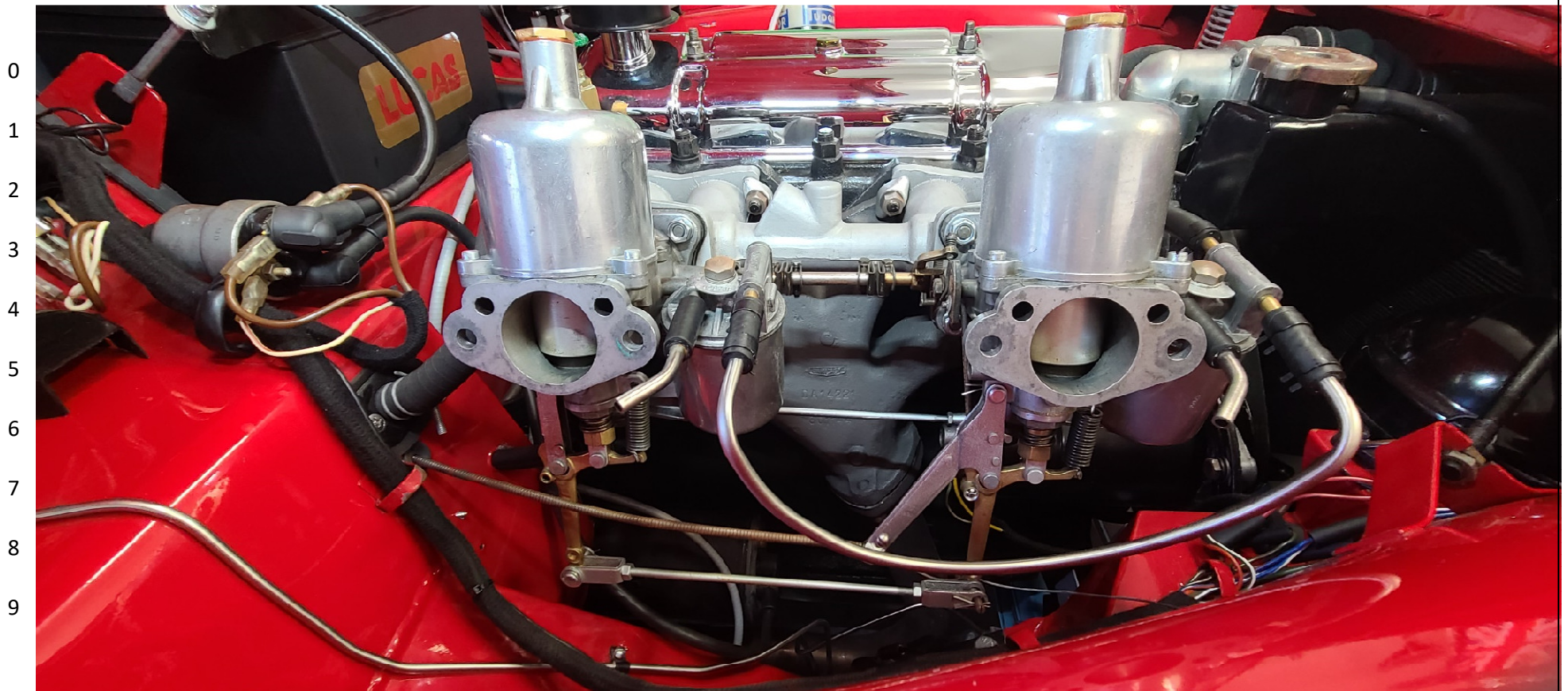

Discussion

This plate shows 2 H6 carburetors and their associated linkage. The purpose of this discussion is to highlight the lower linkage.

At U9: Pay special attention to this installation. The choke linkage fork does not fit between the brass jet lever but is adjacent to it on the right as shown. From left to right is: 1) the nut and washer securing the chock cable to the pin 2) the pin through the jet lever and then through the fork of the rod assembly and finally 3) the pin is secured in place with a cotter pin.

At Q2: This is a TR4 engine fitted to a TCF TR3B so the manifold is different with respect to the balance tube. It has a boss casting whereas all other TR3As and TSF TR3Bs the tube is straight across.

Please refer to the Underhood Standards for the proper finishes for the various linkage components.
